- NYLO's construction and operation policy calls for using energy efficient building materials and techniques, for instance, with its narrow thermal range, the brand's concrete and brick construction reduces electricity usage for heating and cooling.
- Energy-efficient light bulbs are used in guest and meeting rooms.
- Guest lofts feature stand-alone heating and air-conditioning units that can be individually controlled for energy efficiency.
- Each guest loft has a key-card energy management system that automatically turns off the lights when you leave and turns them on when you return.

REUSE

- NYLO Hotels are constructed of eco-friendly concrete that is incorporated into the overall aesthetic of the buildings.
- Recycled building materials are used whenever possible for hotel construction or renovation.
- The LOFT restaurants use the Natura water purification system for all bottled water, including still and sparkling water. All bottles are sterilized and reused.

RECYCLE

- Desk pads and folio binders use recycled paper, and bath amenities come in recycled bottles that have no chemical preservations like Paraben.
- Eco-friendly uniform pants made from recycled plastic bottles.
- Each guest loft will have a blue recyclable bin and all bottles and cardboard discarded by the hotel and guestrooms are recycled.
- Interface carpeting used through the hotel is made from 100% recyclable material.
